Residential Trip to Wales - Arrangements

We are looking forward to our forthcoming trip to Broneirion in Wales and I outline below further details and final arrangements. Please accept my apologies for the last minute nature of this, however as I am sure you can appreciate, this is unavoidable as our new Year 7 pupils have only just started.

Further to my previous correspondence, I can confirm that the total cost of the trip is £220 (including deposit); therefore we require the remaining balance to be paid **no later than Friday 21**st **September.** For the majority this will be £170 for those who paid a deposit of £50. Naturally, if you paid a greater deposit, please adjust the outstanding balance accordingly. Please make payment via cash, cheque or BACS. Cheques should be made payable to Hollygirt School and BACS payments should be referenced 'Wales'.

Additional Information

Timings

We will be leaving school at 9am prompt on the morning Wednesday 26th September and will return by the end of the school day on Friday 28th September. Pupils will require a packed lunch and drinks for this day.

Medication

Should your child require any travel sickness medication or any other medication for the trip, please ensure this is clearly labelled and passed to me on the morning of the trip with relevant instructions.

Bags

Please ensure your child has a small rucksack and either a small suitcase or holdall. Generally, lots of layers would be beneficial for clothing to keep warm.

Money

Only a small amount of spending money will be required- approx £20.

Food

Pupils will be required to bring a packed lunch for the first day, following this, all meals are provided. Any dietary requirements should be noted on the consent and medical form.

Mobile Phones / Gadgets

Pupils are permitted to bring their personal mobile phones, however these are the responsibility of the individual pupil. Pupils are not permitted to bring tablets/gaming devices etc
