## **School Swimming Lessons**

As we approach the end of the first half term, I just wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of important health and safety procedures regarding school swimming lessons and rules that the pool has in place.

- No jewellery is allowed in the pool unless for religious purposes
- No plasters are allowed in the pool
- If a child has an open cut, access to the pool is not allowed
- Hair must be tied back off the face; we are now asking that **a swimming cap is worn** if hair is past the ears
- Only one-piece swimsuits are permitted

It is the expectation that children will **wear plain bottle green swimsuits, with red or green swimming caps.**

Years 1, 2 and 3 have been swimming this half term; Years 4, 5 and 6 will be swimming after half term. This will then alternate throughout the school year.
