Christmas Fair / Visit to Santa – Tuesday 17th December Nursery to Year 6

The Senior School Christmas Fair will take place on **Tuesday 17th December**. We take all junior children over for the afternoon. Parents may pick children up at 1:20pm from the playground to take them to the fair. If you cannot attend, or will be later than 1:20pm, children will be taken across by their teachers. Nursery to Year 2 children will be supervised around the fair, whilst KS2 will be allowed to walk around in pairs, meeting their teachers at the end, to take them back across to Junior School and children can be collected at normal time or from After School Club.

If you arrive during the afternoon and go straight to the fair, please make sure teachers know when you are taking your child home.

We are offering all children the opportunity to visit Santa at the fair. The cost of this will be **£2 per child** and includes a present.

If children have any food allergies, they should take any edible items home as we cannot guarantee ingredients of homemade goods. There may be animals at the fair; please advise us if children will be allowed to pet these should this be the case.

If possible, please could children bring coins rather than notes to spend, as the stall holders can run out of change very quickly! A shopping bag is also advisable.

Singing in the Victoria Centre – Wednesday 18th December Reception to Year 6

As we have done in previous years, the children from **Reception to Year 6** will be singing in the Victoria Centre on **Wednesday 18th December**; Mrs Wand will be able to confirm the exact location nearer to the time. We will sing well-known carols in addition to songs from the children's productions.

The children should come to school as usual in the morning. With staff, they will walk to the Victoria Centre and then back to school after their performances. **Years 3-6 should wear their formal uniform**. All children will be issued with a Santa hat on the day.

We will be performing in the following groups, however, this is just a rough guide as there may be breaks between songs:
