“Waste and the City: Sew Sustainable” Trip to the Urban Room, Nottingham

On Thursday 30th January, pupils from Eco Club and Knit and Natter Club are invited to attend a workshop – “Waste and the City: Sew Sustainable” – at the Urban Room, Carrington Street, Nottingham. The Urban Room is a hub of science, architecture, design and innovation run by the Royal Institute of British Architects, Historic England and Nottingham City Council.

The focus of the day will be on designing and creating an upcycled product made from pre-loved t-shirts, addressing issues about sustainability and recycling. All fabrics and tools will be provided, though the children are welcome to bring one of their own t-shirts if they so wish. The session will be led by Toni Jarvis of Tiger Projects (see tigerprojects.co.uk for more information) and supported by Hollygirt staff.

The children should attend school as normal in their full uniform, including blazers, and shall walk to the Urban Room at around 9am. They will be back in time for normal end-of-day proceedings, including clubs. There is no charge for this visit.
