Year 7 & 8 Residential Trip
Tuesday 21st September to Friday 24th September 2021

It is with great pleasure to announce that we intend to organise a residential trip for the Autumn Term. This will be an optional trip for all Year 7 & 8 pupils (as of September 2021). It will be over three nights and four days between Tuesday 21st to Friday 24th September 2021.

The venue will be Broneirion in central Wales (The home of Girlguiding in Wales). The aim of the trip is for pupils to get to know others in the group, build confidence and friendships. Planned outcomes are to attempt activities which are increasingly challenging to build confidence and resilience.

The location and venue are fantastic and we will take part in many adventure, teambuilding and fun activities (both on dry land and in the water). The price is an estimate at this stage, as it depends on final numbers but is currently expected to be between £350 - £400 per person. I believe this offers excellent value for money, the price will include all transport, food, accommodation and activities. Once numbers have been finalised, I will write to confirm the final cost.
