Visit to Skegness – Tuesday 13th July 2021

I am delighted to confirm that we have arranged a trip to Skegness on **Tuesday 13th July 2021** for all pupils in years 7, 8, 9 and 10. The trip has been planned as a fun end of the year enrichment day for the pupils.

We have booked four coaches so each year group will travel and move around Skegness as a year group bubble. All children will need to wear a relaxed school uniform; they therefore do not need to bring a blazer and have permission to wear their trainers. They are to also bring an overcoat (with hood). In addition, they will need to bring a packed lunch and snacks (including drinks), sun cream and sun hat. Pupils will also require some spending money for an ice cream/souvenir and for the Fantasy Island theme park rides. No more than £30 should be brought on this trip.

Should you wish to provide your child with travel sickness medicine, please label the packet and pass to their Tutor mentor for safekeeping. Your child will need to arrive at school at **8.40am** and we will return to school at **4.30pm**. We have extended the school day to make the most of our time at the coast. Homework club will run as usual until 5pm.

The cost of this visit is £24 and you can pay by cheque, cash or BACS (BACS is preferred). Cheques should be made payable to Hollygirt School. If paying via BACS, please title your payment SURNAME/SKEGNESS. If you wish for your child to accompany us on this trip, please complete and return the slip below along with payment by Friday 11th June 2021.
