CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

The terms and conditions are that the student shows determination and willpower in terms of practice and playing.

APPLICATION PROCESS

You will need to provide a reference form from your son or daughter's current Music teacher which briefly outlines their contribution so far to their instrument.

In addition, there will be a short performance for the Head of Music / Head with a few informal questions.
