

Sources of support: examples

- Parents, family members or friends = listening, empathy, emotional support ٠ strategies
- ٠ Someone's partner = listening, empathy, emotional support strategies
- cop Teachers or other trusted adults = listening, empathy, safeguarding, emotional ٠ support strategies
- GPs and other medical professionals = medical advice, medical assessment, ٠ accurate, reliable, non-biased information, safeguarding, refer someone for an abortion
- Counsellors = listening, empathy, therapeutic support ٠
- Advice lines, charities, specialist organisations = listening, empativ, emotional ٠ support strategies, reliable information (depending on the organisation)
